Dear Parents,

Ysgol Pen Barras Adverse Weather Arrangements

As you are aware, there is a Yellow Weather Warning across parts of North Wales tonight for ice and snow between 7pm and 10.00am tomorrow morning. We are not sure what will transpire tomorrow morning, but felt it a good opportunity to remind parents of Adverse Weather procedures here at Ysgol Pen Barras.

1. There will be a risk assessment in place which will be based on two main factors when considering adverse weather conditions- site safety and also staffing levels. Please remember, a high percentage of our staff live in rural areas and could face travel disruption. Conditions may be fine in Ruthin but not in other rural areas which could impact travel arrangements.
2. Depending upon staffing levels, the school could decide to close fully or issue partial closure. This could mean opening for specific units based on staff available.
3. If there is a decision to close the school, we will look to do this as early as possible in the morning in order to give parents sufficient time to make alternative arrangements in terms of work and child care commitments. If there is no message from the school office, the school will therefore be open as usual for all.

Once a decision is made to close the school, we will notify parents via email and will also post update on our school app and Facebook page. We will also notify Denbighshire County Council and it will be included on their data base/ website.

The decision to close a school is not one which is taken lightly.

We hope the weather forecast for tonight is not as severe as suggested and that we can look forward to seeing everyone at school tomorrow.
